CFMA CHAIRMAN'S COIN CHALLENGE













On March 21, 2022 Rich Shavell was presented with a CFMA Chairman's Challenge Coin for his efforts assisting Construction Financial Management Association ("CFMA") produce a new educational product for its membership. Rich was one of three technical reviewers for what will be CFMA's Tax Answer Book, the brainchild of longtime CFMA member Al Clark. CFMA's Tax Answer Book is projected to be available, on a subscription basis, later in 2022.

In 2018, then-CFMA Chairman Joe McLaughlin wanted to recognize members who do exceptional work for CFMA, but whose efforts might not be acknowledged at CFMA's Executive level. He was reminded of the military tradition of the challenge coin - a small medallion or token that signifies a person is a member of an elite group. Since then, CFMA Executive Committee members have followed the tradition of giving out a limited number of Chairman's Challenge Coins to CFMA members who exhibit service and excellence to CFMA (https://cfma.org/chairmanscoin).
